## VILLAGE OF WINDHAM OHIO ORDINANCE O-2011-18

## AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE RATE OF PAY FOR THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF WINDHAM

WHEREAS, the Village of Windham has decided to establish a new rate of pay for the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that the rate of pay for the Mayor should be substantially similar to the rate of pay which is paid to Township Trustees under Ohio Revised Code Section 505.24 under which the amount of the pay is linked to the size of the municipal budget; and

WHEREAS, in conformity with Ohio Law, the rate of pay as established in this Ordinance shall be prospective in nature only, and shall take effect upon the beginning of the next term of the Mayor, regardless of whether the individual next elected is new to the position of Mayor, or whether the present Mayor is re-elected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Windham, County of Portage, State of Ohio, a majority or more of the members thereto elected concurring that:

Section 1: Beginning with the Mayoral term commencing on January 1, 2012, the rate of pay for the Mayor of the Village of Windham shall be the same as a Township Trustee as is set forth in section of Ohio Revised Code 505.24.

It is hereby found and determined that all actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
